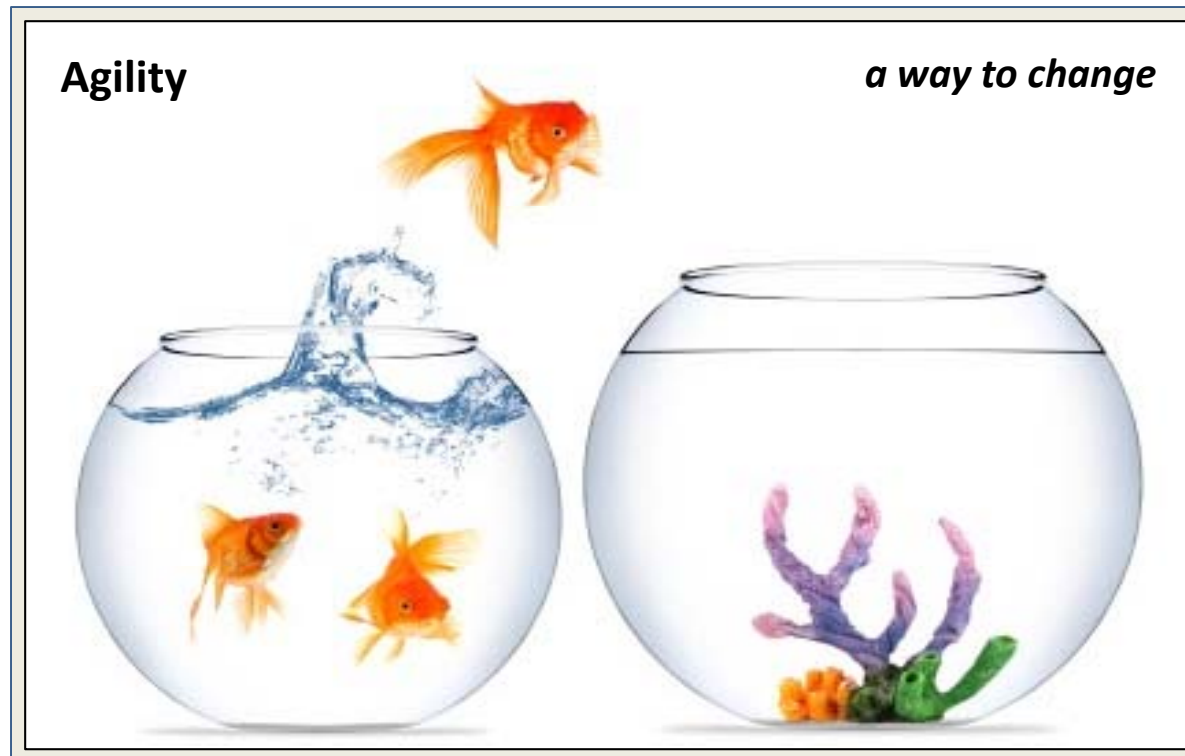


Project Management Cameos - 8. Agility of not being agile



Agile
